## In Nursery,

- 3- and 4-year olds will be learning to:
- Develop their sense of responsibility and membership of a community.
- Understand gradually how others might be feeling.
- Continue developing positive attitudes about the differences between people.

## In Reception,

## Children will be learning to:

- Build constructive and respectful relationships.
- Express their feelings and consider the feelings of others.
- Think about the perspectives of others.
- Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways.
- Recognise some environments that are different from the one in which they live.

## **Useful terminology:**

Similarities: the same as someone else

Differences: not the same as someone else

Religion: the rules and beliefs you and your family have

Country: A place in the world where you live or you are from or would like to visit

Relationship: a connection with someone you like and trust

Can you tell me a religion you have learnt about?

What country do you live in?

What country are you from?
